## LIQUORLAND ENDURO CHALLENGE POMEROY-DUNDEE WFO

### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Held under the General Competition Rules and Standing Supplementary Regulations of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued by the Organisers.

#### 1. M.S.A PERMIT NUMBER: 8245

MSA flag will be used to start the event, and will be displayed for the duration of the event.

#### VENUE

POMEROY-DUNDEE

#### DATE

7 August 2010

#### STATUS

The event will form round FOUR of the 2010 Kwa Zulu Natal Regional Motorcycle ENDURO Championship. Classes available are 200cc, Open, juniors, Seniors and Masters. Additional Non-Championship classes will also be available CLUBMANS, (non championship) and an entry level non scoring ( Adventure Class) which is aimed at first time riders trying out W F O and ADVENTURE CLASS type riders who just want a casual ride. This is a class being introduced on a trial basis to attract some of our ex riders back, to get some of the older riders into the game and to give newcomers a taste of enduro, without being thrown into the deep end. This class will be run over one lap of the course. Competitors are required to be licensed.

#### DESCRIPTION

Refer to Article 7 of the ENDURO Regulations ( Regional ) and Specifications MSA Handbook.  
The route will be marked in accordance with Article 28 of the Specifications in MSA Handbook 2010.

#### ELIGIBILITY AND PRE-START REQUIREMENTS

Competitors: Refer to **Art. 9** of the ENDURO Regulations and Specifications MSA Handbook.  
N.B.: Should the route cross and/or use public roads, competitors whose competition licences are endorsed "not valid for events which use public roads" will not be permitted to enter the event.  
Refer to SSR 332 & 341 of the OFF ROAD MOTORCYCLE Regulations & Specifications MSA Handbook.  
ADVENTURE CLASS have to have an X taped across their number boards.

#### **PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO 1 , FIRST AID KIT , 2 MEDICAL BOARD , 3 DRINKING LIQUID**

#### ENTRIES

Entries open immediately and close 48 hours prior to the event. The entry fee will be R 350.00 for all regional entries and R200.00 for the entry level riders. Late entries will be R150.00 extra. ## DOCUMENTATION, SCRUTINEERING & RIDERS' BRIEFING

Documentation will take place between 07.30 AND 09.30 AT THE VENUE. All competitors must place their machines on the correct start grids by 09.30. Riders Briefing will take place at 09.30 at the venue.

## START

The start will be at 10.00 and will be as per enduro regulations (except for ADVENTURE CLASS who will start after the rest of the field in a mass start. This is at the discretion of the Organisers.) **NOTE: THIS WILL BE A DEAD ENGINE START.**

## PRE-RACE PRACTICING

Refer to Art. 40 & 47 of the ENDURO Regulations & Specification MSA Handbook. (Will result in exclusion )

## OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE

Outside assistance is allowed.

## 2. REPORTING OF ACCIDENTS/INCIDENTS & RETIREMENTS.

Retirement: Should a competitor retire from the event, he is to immediately notify the nearest marshal/official of this fact. Competitors who have retired from the event must proceed to Race Control ASAP, and hand in their Route Card. Failure to comply with this regulation may result in the entry of the competitor concerned being refused by the Organisers for future events and/or a fine of **R1000.00** will be levied.

Refer SSR 61, MSA Handbook.

In particular competitors are required to notify the Organisers of any damaged fences, gates so that the necessary repairs may be carried out.

## COMPETITOR CONDUCT

Injuries: In the event of anyone being injured competitors are obliged to stop and render whatever assistance may be needed. REFER ARTICLE 25 of MSA Handbook . In the case of serious injury do not move the injured the injured competitor unless he is in a dangerous position. **The next Marshall must be informed as soon as possible in order to summon assistance, the Marshall is to be supplied with the name and riding number of the injured competitor, and approximate location. When an ambulance is encountered on route, it has right of way at all times.**

**Note:** Once competitors have retired from or finished the event their motorcycles are to be parked and/or trailored. **Under no circumstances will competitors or helpers be allowed to ride their machines once they have completed the event. Failure to adhere to this will result in exclusion from the event.**

## PENALTIES & EXCLUSIONS

Refer Art. 43 of the Enduro Regulations & specifications MSA Handbook.

In addition the following penalties will apply:

Failure to attend riders' briefing:	15 minutes
Failure to hand in route card	Exclusion
Missing a check point	15 minutes
Riding motorcycle after finishing	Exclusion

**NOTE. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm that his route card is marked by the relevant check machine.**

## 3. RESULTS/AWARDS

The organizers will endeavor to post provisional results in good time after the last competitor completes the course. These results will become final thirty (30) minutes after their being posted, subject to no protests being received in terms of GCR 197-200 MSA Handbook. Refer Parts IX and X MSA Handbook.

Prize giving will commence once the results are final.

Awards will be made to the riders placed first to third in their respective classes. No awards will be presented to the ADVENTURE CLASS but the Organisers reserve the right to change this.

**Note:** All awards will be distributed at prize giving. Any competitor who is not present and who has not made prior arrangement with the clerk of the course or secretary of the meeting shall forfeit all such awards. Refer GCR 280(iii)

#### **6. ROUTE**

The route shall consist of little used roads and foot paths and shall be approximately 120 KMS for the regional classes and 80 KMS for the clubman and vet classes. The ADVENTURE CLASS shall complete one lap.

Livestock and game may be encountered along the route and you are requested to give them right of way at all times.

In many places the route may be narrow and dust may also be a problem, you should therefore afford any competitor who has caught up with you, every opportunity to overtake.

The residents in the area have afforded us the privilege of staging this event through both remote and populated areas. Please exercise caution through kraals and cultivated areas and where livestock is concerned. In order that this event may continue to take place in the future, competitors are required to act responsibly.

#### **7. ROAD CROSSINGS**

**NO RACING ON PUBLIC ROADS IS ALLOWED AT ANY EVENT, IRRESPECTIVE OF THE EVENT'S STATUS. RACING ON PUBLIC ROADS IS ILLEGAL AND ORGANISERS OF AN EVENT THAT MAKES USE OF PUBLIC ROADS MUST ADHERE TO SECTION 317 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS.**
