LIQUORLAND ENDURO CHALLENGE RICHMOND SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS *10 & 11 SEPTEMBER 2010*

Held under the General Competition Rules and Standing Supplementary Regulations of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), these Supplementary Regulations, KZN circular 04/2010 and any Final Instructions issued by the Organisers.

1. **MOTORSPORT South Africa PERMIT NUMBER: 11034**
The MSA flag will be flown in a prominent position at main control.
2. **VENUE:** RICHMOND COUNTRY CLUB.
3. **DATE:** 10 & 11 SEPTEMBER 2010
4. **STATUS:** National & Regional Enduro Championship & Club/Silver Class Event
- 4.1 **The event will form the fifth round of the 2010 Liquorland National Motorcycle Enduro Championship.**
- 4.2 The event will form the fifth round of the 2010 Kwa Zulu Natal Enduro Championship.
5. **DESCRIPTION**
 - 5.1 Refer to article 1 of the Enduro SSR's.
 - 5.2 The route will consist of a combination of regularity and special tests.
 - 5.3 The route will be marked in accordance with Article 28 of the Enduro SSR's. (See final instructions)
 - 5.4 No impound overnight.
 - 5.5 The event will be run on SA Standard Time.
6. **ELIGIBILITY AND PRE -START REQUIREMENTS**
 - 6.1.1 **COMPETITORS:** Refer to Article 9a of the Enduro SSR's. Please supply copies of all documents with entry form to speed up documentation.
 - 6.2 National and Regional numbers must be obtained from Cindy Correia (011) 4662440 at MSA. Numbers must be supplied by the competitor.
 - 6.3 **MOTORCYCLES:** Refer Article 9b. of the Enduro SSR's.
 - 6.4 **ADVERTISING:** Refer to GCR 246 (iii) "Sponsors advertising material must be displayed. Refer also GCR 247.
 - 6.5 **ACQUAINTANCE AND SUBMISSION TO THE RULES:** Refer GCR 122.
 - 6.6.1 **CLASSES:**
National Championship class entries will be as per Article 12 of the Enduro SSR's.
Regional Championship class entries will be as per Article 12 of the Enduro SSR's and KZN circular 04/2010.

There will be no Adventure classes on the day.

8 **DOCUMENTATION, SCRUTINEERING AND RIDER'S BRIEFING:**
NATIONAL, REGIONAL

8.1 Documentation and Scrutineering will take place between 12-00Pm and 20h00 on 10th September 2010 at the Richmond Country Club.

8.2 Any motorcycle not scrutineered will be excluded from the event. Refer to GCR 253

8.3.1 Riders Briefing for above competitors will take place at 07.00am on 11th September 2010 at the Richmond Country Club. There will be a Parc Ferme from 6-30am on the 11th September 2010.

9. **START AND FINISH**

REGIONAL & NATIONAL

9.1 The start will be at 8-00AM at the Richmond Country Club. Article 21 of the Enduro SSR's refers. The event will finish at The Richmond Country Club at approximately 16h00. All competitors must place their motorcycles into parc ferme.

10. **PRE-RACE PRACTISING: Please note the route is closed and there will be no practice allowed...**

11. **OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE:** Competitors attention is drawn to Article 24 of the Enduro SSR's

13.2 **INCIDENT REPORT FORMS:** All competitors will be issued with an Incident Report Form at documentation. This form is to be handed in with the Route Card either on completion or retirement from the event. Should a competitor fail to report any incident involving damage to any person or property in addition to the penalty laid down in Art.27 of the Enduro SSR's , the competitor may be

reported to MSA for further action. In particular competitors are required to notify the organisers of any damaged fences or gates so that the necessary repairs may be carried out.

Provisional results will be announced as soon as possible after the last competitor completes the course. Results will be posted at 20h00. These results will become final thirty (30) minutes after being posted at Main Control, subject to no protests being received.
17. **PROTESTS AND APPEALS:** Competitors' attention is drawn to Parts IX and X and Appendix "R" of the MSA Handbook for protests and appeals.
18. **AWARDS:** Awards in the form of trophies will be made to the riders placed first to six in all classes in the National and Regional Events, as well as in the Club and Junior classes.
19. **PRIZEGIVING:** Will take place at THE RICHMOND COUNTRY CLUB, RICHMOND at 20h30. This will be in the form of a dinner, starting at 19h00, extra dinner tickets will be available at Documentation. There will be ONE refuel point at the start finish area. Refueling will take place in the demarcated areas. Every competitor is required to carry one litre of drinking fluid, a first aid kit, medical board and have at least a 2.5kg fire extinguisher at their refuel point, which will be presented at documentation. Only local pump fuel is permitted. Fuel will not be available at the venue. The use of methanol is not permitted.

DISTANCE

The distance covered will be not less than 160km or less than 5 hours of riding time. The course will cross public roads and the organisers are aware and have acquainted themselves with the provisions of section 317 of the Road Traffic Act and relevant permission is in place.
